What is bullying?



What does a bully do?

Bullies may do **some** or **all** of these things:

punch	spread rumours	pinch
pull hair	slap	give nasty looks
call people names	'leave people out'	send nasty notes/ e-mails/texts
kick	push	Spoil/take your things

How do people who are being bullied behave?



- *they are sad
- *they don't want to come to school
- *they pretend they are ill
- *they don't want to go out to play
- *they cry
- *they may not want to eat their dinner

How are we going to make sure that bullying does not happen in our school?

We will learn about being good citizens in assembly, in PSE lessons and through 'anti-bullying' week.

We will have a 'WORRY BOX' in our hall where children can post all their worries including those about bullying .



Teachers will keep a record of all incidents of bullying. The head teacher will tell the bully's parents/carers and the victim's parents/carers.

We will have an anti-bullying notice board where we will put up advice for people being bullied, our anti-bullying policy and our anti-bullying messages.
